2. Policy, Quorum and Attendance

(g) Subject to the requirements of law for notice of meetings, unless otherwise restricted by the Certificate of Formation or these Bylaws, members of the Board, the general membership, or members of any committee may participate in and hold a meeting of the Board, membership or committee, as the case may be, by means of a telephone conference or by similar communications equipment, or another suitable electronic communications system, including videoconferencing technology or the Internet, or any combination, if the telephone or other equipment or system permits each person participating in the meeting to communicate with all other persons participating in the meeting. Participation in such meeting shall constitute presence in person at such meeting, unless the participation is for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of business at the meeting on the ground that the meeting has not been lawfully called or convened. If voting is to take place at the meeting, the Association must:

(i) Implement reasonable measures to verify that every person voting at the meeting by means of remote communications is sufficiently identified; and

(ii) Keep a record of any vote or other action taken.
